



Chester Raccoon Paper Face Project



Materials (per student):

- 1 - 9x12 blue construction paper
- 1 - 3x6 brown rectangle (face-bottom)
- 1 - 3x4 brown rectangle (face-top)
- 1 - 1.5x1.5 brown square (ears)
- 1 - 2x4 black rectangle (mask)
- 1 - 2x2 black square (nose)
- 1 - 1x2 black rectangle (eyes)
- 1 - 2x3 white rectangle (eyes)
- 1 - red paper heart



Directions:

1. Face-bottom: Cut and round all four corners of the 3x6 brown rectangle. Glue it to the bottom of blue construction paper.
2. Face-top: Glue 3x4 brown rectangle above the first brown 3x6 rectangle so that the edges touch.
3. Ears: Take the 1.5 brown square and cut it diagonally so that you have 2 triangles. Glue the 2 brown triangles above the 3x4 brown rectangle so that the edges touch.
4. Mask: Take the 2x4 black rectangle and round the 4 corners. Glue it on top of the 3x4 brown rectangle piece.
5. Eyes (white): Take the 2x3 white rectangle and fold it in half hamburger style. Cut and round all 4 corners. Open and cut on the fold line so that you have 2 white ovals. Glue 2 white ovals in the middle of the black mask.
6. Eyes (black): Take the 1x2 black rectangle. Fold it in half hamburger style. Cut and round all 4 corners. Open and cut on the fold line so that you have 2 black circles. Glue the 2 black circles in the middle of the white ovals.
7. Nose: Take the 2x2 black square, and cut it diagonally so that you have 2 triangles. Glue 1 black triangle under the black mask inverted. Discard the 2nd triangle.
8. Glue the red heart anywhere on the page.
9. Use a black marker to draw a smile for Chester.
